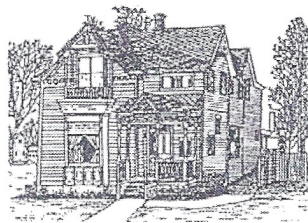
The celebration includes music at 1:15, the pageantry of the Santa Lucia parade at 2:15, and caroling accompanied by the pump organ at 3:15.
