The Waldemar Ager Association, a nonprofit 501 (c)(3) organization, celebrates Nordic Culture and the work of author and publisher Waldemar Ager (1869 - 1941). Ager's home, located at 514 W. Madison Street, Eau Claire, WI, operates as a museum and cultural/educational center. The museum has a library of more than 1,500 items for the study of Nordic languages, history, literature, and culture and for genealogical research.

What the Association Needs

The organization expects the successful candidate to promote the mission of the Association by focusing on the home, heritage, and literary works of Waldemar Ager and by developing strong connections to local and regional communities. The successful candidate will seek ways to maintain and develop membership and funding for the organization.
